Description: Correspondence, March-October, 1917, between W. A. Graham, Commissioner of Agriculture, and H. H. Brimley, Curator, with the officials of the Southern States Exposition. The Exposition was sponsored by the Southern Commercial Congress to publicize agriculture, industry, colonizations with exhibits of raw materials and manufactures of the South. Floor plans for the Exposition at Hotel Astor and the 71st Regiment Armory in New York City, resolution of the New York General Assembly and a proclamation from the governor of New York endorsing the Exposition, a brochure advertising it, and a program of the ninth annual session of the Southern Commercial Congress are included in the papers.
