Physical Description: Bond and mortgage, deeds (typescripts). 3 items.

Description: These typescripts are a bond and mortgage from George Durant, mariner of Albemarle County, North Carolina, to Nicholas Page and Joshua Lamb, October 12, 1672, for Durant's brigantine "Recovery"; a deed from Governor William Berkeley of Virginia to Joshua Lamb, New England merchant, for "the whole Island of Roanoke scituate and being in the County of Albemarle," April 17, 1676; and a deed from Joshua Lamb to Nicholas Paige (Page), Boston, to a "full halfe part of that his Island called Roanoke," September 19, 1677. The typescripts are from Suffolk Deeds, Liber VII, X, XIII (1894, 1899, 1903).
